The Pancake boat is former lifeboat which has been converted into a 2 person restaurant. The boat is propelled by 16 frying pans in 2 paddle wheels. The captain and the cook bug their customers with pancakes and syrup.

CONDITIONS

A place to charge the batteries.

Ramp to let the boat into and out of the water, or a crane to do so.

To prevent damage to the paddle wheels, the boat has to be moored at the front. This means the boat sticks 7 meters into the water, from the shore.

The pan paddle boat can sail two hours twice a day. In between the batteries of the boat have to be charged for at least two hours.
